Sibel Ogden of the Town of Unandilla in the County of Otsego- aged seventy three years- duly sworn says: That she is the daughter of Col Henry Ludington (Deceased) formerly of the County of Dutchess; That she knew Jonathan Carley, who now resides in the Town of Sidney in the County of Delaware, during the War of the Revolution; That her father during the war resided in Fredericks Town in the County of Dutchess and commanded a Regiment of militia; That he also commanded a Corps or Regiment of men entitled "minute men" but cannot say in what year that corps was raised; That her father was frequently and almost constantly engaged in active service from the commencement to the close of the war near what was then called "the lines", and elsewhere at occasion occurred in repressing the incursions of the British and Tories; That during the War the said Carley was often at her father's house; That she had no distinct recollection of any such particular services rendered by him but from conversation with said Carley and from various facts and circumstances related by him with which the deponent was acquainted at the time they occurred, she believes he must have served occasionally as a soldier in her father's Regiment; That detachments from said Regiment were almost constantly kept upon the alert to counteract the designs and incursions of the Tories and British and believes that said Carley was occasionally at least engaged in such detached service.
